Summary:

- proof of vaccine is not required to ride the lifts.
- there is some outdoor seating available, as well as washrooms and a yurt and warming containers that do not require proof of vaccine. There are 1-2 options to buy food outside.
- proof of vaccine IS required for people 12+ to enter into the Main Lodge, Glory Lodge, or ride the shuttle. This includes upstairs and downstairs.
- proof of vaccine is not required to enter the skier services or ski rental areas.
- masks must be worn on and around the chair lifts and in ALL buildings.

From Whitewater staff:

“How does this affect the school's program? As we have the yurt and warming containers available for school groups, we are still able to accommodate school groups this season. Students will have access to the outdoor washrooms located outside of the Skier Services lodge. There are also washrooms at the Glory Lodge and parking lot near the Summit Chair. The Taco Tin will also be available for those who are not vaccinated and wish to buy food. They can also buy food to go outside of the Glory Lodge. Anyone who is 12 and older and unvaccinated will not be able to buy food or use the washrooms inside the Main Lodge or inside the Glory Lodge.”
